

EXCLUSIONS FROM ATTENDANCE

Students may be excluded from attendance in enrichment classes, field trips, and other school activities as follows:

1. The Governing Board may exclude a child of filthy or vicious habits, or children suffering from an illness and contagious or infectious diseases.
2. The Governing Board may exclude a child whose physical or mental disability is such as to cause his/her attendance to be inimical to the welfare of the other students.
3. The Governing Board may exclude a child who does not present evidence of immunization from certain infectious diseases as required by law unless the parent or guardian requests, in a written statement, exemption from the requirement on the basis of a conflict with the religious beliefs of the parent or guardian.
4. The Governing Board may exclude a child who does not demonstrate appropriate mannerism especially in the areas of speech, behavior and attitude. **(See BP 5640)**
5. The Governing Board may exclude a child for inappropriate grooming and attire. **(See BP 5650)**
