SCHOOL YEAR

The Governing Board requires that teachers/parents instruct a minimum of 175 days to complete a school year. All days in which a child is unable to attend school, except for excused absences (as outlined in BP5240(a) (c)) will need to be made up be extending the school year.

The teacher/parent may determine which school calendar (traditional or year round) it will follow, and must submit a proposed calendar prior to starting the school year. The proposed calendar will indicate the days in which the teacher/parent plans to instruct their student(s) as well as any days designated as non school days (NS) such as: holidays, vacations, etc.

Parents who enroll their children in CCA after the open enrollment period (June 1-September 30) may be denied admittance if the governing board determines that:

- a. They failed to satisfy admission requirements outlined in **BP5100**
- b. They will be unable to comply with the 175 day teaching policy.
- c. The student(s) in question has/have not been previously enrolled in a school (public/private)
- d. The student(s) in question is/are not currently being home schooled.
- e. The parent(s) have been denied HSLDA membership.
