

**GRADING SYSTEM****GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)**

Grade point averages shall be computed as follows:

A = 4

B = 3

C = 2

D = 1

F = 0

The grade-point average is determined by dividing the total number of grade points by the total number of classes. Not to be computed into the GPA are grades or credits earned in courses which offer only pass-fail grades. The school principal shall determine those courses which can be offered as a pass/fail grade.

Honors courses which are taken in the last two years of high school and which are designated by the California State University system or the University of California for bonus points will earn the following points in the calculation of the grade point average:

A = 5

B = 4

C = 3

D = 2

F = 0
